

WASHINGTON—Today, U.S. Representative Mike Quigley (IL-05) issued the following statement after the Obama Administration issued new guidelines regarding for-profit colleges.

“I applaud the decision by the Obama administration to empower students and bring much-needed transparency and accountability to the for-profit college industry. Thanks to the new rules, these colleges must now be up front about accreditation and provide detailed explanations of costs and success rates.
