I am requesting funding for Rehabilitative Resurfacing of Belmont Avenue - 25th Ave to West of Elm St, in Franklin Park, Illinois in surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor for this project is the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and the project is located on Belmont Avenue – 25th Avenue to West of Elm St, Franklin Park, IL 60131.

The funding is designated for rehabilitative resurfacing and replacing non-compliant curb ramps to make them compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
