To require the Attorney General to study whether an individual's history of domestic violence can be used to determine the likelihood of such individual committing a mass shooting.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. STUDY ON WHETHER AN INDIVIDUAL'S HIS-
2	TORY OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CAN BE USED
3	TO DETERMINE THE LIKELIHOOD OF SUCH
4	INDIVIDUAL COMMITTING A MASS SHOOTING.
5	Not later than 12 months after the date of enactment
6	of this Act, the Attorney General of the United States
7	shall complete a study and submit a report to the Con-
8	gress on whether an individual's history of domestic vio-
