THE INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT WILL:

Create good-paying jobs, invest in a foundation for strong economic growth, and ensure all communities can compete & succeed in the 21st Century

WHAT THIS WILL MEAN FOR CHICAGO:

- S4 billion for public transit systems like CTA and Metra so we can extend the red line, rebuild the blue line, and make sure that every station is ADA accessible so communities in Chicago has safe, reliable, useful public transit
- Over \$10 billion for repairs to bridges and roads like the Webster Street Bridge and Lake Shore Drive
- S1.7 billion for clean, safe drinking water for our homes, schools, and childcare centers
- \$148 million to expand our electric vehicle infrastructure and close the gap between states like Illinois, which is ranked near the bottom for EV infrastructure, and California, which is ranked near the top
- S600 million dollars for airports in our state, including about S70 million a year for O'Hare for the next 5 years
- Funding to make approximately 2.9 million Illinoisans eligible for benefits for cheaper internet access
