I am requesting funding for CTA Addison Red Line Station South Exit Improvement Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Chicago Transit Authority (CTA), located at 567 W. Lake St Chicago, IL 60661. The funding would be used to help bring the Addison Red Line Station to a state of good repair by making various improvements that include rebuilding the auxiliary exit of the Addison Red Line Station (south side of Addison) to make what is currently an exit-only location into an entrance to the station. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it offers CTA riders a better transit experience by making investments in a well-trafficked station and bolstering critical rider safety improvements. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code.
