I am requesting \$2,339,843 in funding for two hybrid Pace suburban buses in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Pace Suburban Bus Division of the Regional Transportation Authority, located at 550 West Algonquin Road, Arlington Heights, IL 60005.

The funding would be used to reach their goal of a zero-emission bus fleet by 2040. Pace recognizes its responsibility for pollution reduction and decreasing its carbon footprint to improve the quality of the community's environment. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it offers Pace riders an improved transit experience by making investments in pollution reduction, decreasing maintenance costs, and ensuring residents have access to modern and comfortable buses for their commutes.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code.
