Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting \$3,000,000 in funding for the Village of Barrington Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrades in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Barrington located at 200 S. Hough St, Barrington, IL 60010. The funding would be used for upgrading 25 pieces of unreliable and failing equipment at the Village of Barrington's wastewater treatment plant to lower phosphorus and nitrogen levels in water; improve water clarity; and improve oxygen demand to receiving streams for wildlife and vegetation.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help the Village of Barrington ensure that the water discharging meets all limits and future limits set by the EPA by lowering phosphorus levels in water; improving water clarity; and improving oxygen demand to receiving streams for wildlife and vegetation. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
