I am requesting \$2,000,000 in funding for the Village of Arlington Heights Lead Service Line Replacement in fiscal year 2026. The funding would be used for replacing the over 4,000 lead service lines that exist within the Village of Arlington Heights to come into compliance with the revised Illinois EPA and U.S. EPA regulations.
