Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting \$1,100,000 in funding for Get Behind the Vest in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation located at 1407 W. Washington Blvd, Chicago, IL 60607. The funding would be used for purchasing at least 2,000 new ballistic vests and covers to Chicago Police Officers whose vest warranty has expired.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because federal programs provide line of duty death benefits to the families of fallen officers. In 2024, firearm related fatalities were the leading primary cause of line of duty deaths for police officers nationwide. Providing this potentially life-saving equipment to Chicago's officers could have a direct impact on the related federal government programs referenced. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1). I certify that I have no financial interest in this project, and neither does anyone in my immediate family.
